FoL Official Voucher Currency Outline

For every 1 (one) dram Avoirdupois of any of these given metals held in Reserve, or contained in a Voucher specimen itself, the FoL Official Treasury may issue up to, but no more than:

- β1 Rhoda (Z4,096 dolus) for Rhodium (Rh).
- ♦1 Aurus (₹256 dolus) for Gold (Au).
- • 1 Argen (₹16 dolus) for Silver (Ag).
- ₹1 Dolus (Dolus being the base unit) for Nickel (Ni).
- ¤1 Cupro (Z1/16 dolus) for Copper (Cu).
- | 1 Ferro (Z1/256 dolus) for Iron (Fe).

The Metals may also be substituted for eachother,- whether for being held in Reserve, for being used for FoL Voucher Currency redemption, for producing FoL Voucher Currency itself, or for any other such thing as is deemed reasonable by the FoL Administration.

Units of mass given are in Avoirdupois measure:

- 1 dram Rhodium may be substituted for and with: 1 ounce Gold; or 1 pound Silver; or 16 pounds Nickel; or 256 pounds Copper; or 4,096 pounds Iron; or any mix thereof.
- 1 dram Gold may be substituted for and with: 1 ounce Silver; or 1 pound Nickel; or 16 pounds Copper; or 256 pounds Iron; or any mix thereof.
- 1 dram Silver may be substituted for and with: 1 ounce Nickel; or 1 pound Copper; or 16 pounds Iron; or any mix thereof.
- 1 dram Nickel may be substituted for and with: 1 ounce Copper; or 1 pound Iron; or any mix thereof.
- 1 dram Copper may be substituted for and with: 1 ounce iron; or any mix thereof.

The currency units shall be further outlined with these exact values:

- β 1 Rhoda = \Leftrightarrow 16 Aurus = \mathbb{Z} 4,096 Dolus

- Z1 Dolus = Z1 Dolus (Dolus is the main unit)
- ¤1 Cupro = 16 Ferro = ₹1/16 Dolus
- | 1 Ferro = ₹1/256 Dolus

The denominations of our voucher currency shall be limited to these exact values and denominations. There shall be no denominations other than the ones hereof, from highest to lowest value:

- Rhoda denominations of β8, β4, β2, and β1 Rhoda
- Aurus denominations of ♦8, ♦4, ♦2, and ♦1 Aurus
- Dolus denominations of ₹8, ₹4, ₹2, and ₹1 Dolus
- Cupro denominations of ¤8, ¤4, ¤2, and ¤1 Cupro

• Ferro denominations of \$\forall 8, \$\forall 4, \$\forall 2\$, and \$\forall 1\$ Ferro

Exchange of Vouchers for National Currencies and Metals may be limited based on Membership status. However, the minimum Metals rates shall be upheld, regardless of current Metals prices. FoL Official Members may be allowed to receive more metals than required, up to a reasonable amount, but not exceeding the fair market value of such metals at the current exchange rate.

Higher-ranking Members are more likely to receive more of the Metals per face value of vouchers than lower-ranking Members. Non-Members shall not be permitted to exchange their vouchers, as this privilege is only reserved for Official Members of the FoL.

 For example, a verified FoL Official Member may exchange a Dolus for 1 ounce of copper, or even more, so long as the total metal's value is below the value of the FoL Vouchers being exchanged. This is to prevent abuse of the system, and to keep the rates consistent, while ensuring the stability of the system.

The exchange rate from FoL Voucher Currency unto National Currencies may be a complex subject, as different Currencies around the would tend to change in value relative to one another. As such, this rate may be subject to change to better suit the needs of the FoL Official Organization. However, these Metal rates shall not change. If any Metal's value reaches beyond a certain threshold, we shall re-evaluate the FoL voucher currency's tie to any other currency.

The Metal market value of the Metal backing them shall not exceed Face value when issued. The target ratio for Metal value shall range from 1/16 (one-sixteenth) to 1/2 (one-half) of Face value. The actual rate may, however, vary, as market prices may change at any time without notice. It is preferred that the FoL vouchers do contain Metal in them, and meet the specific weight requirements. However, it may take time for all new Voucher Notes to, but our Voucher Coins all shall contain a specific amount of metal based on our Metal-Backing system.
