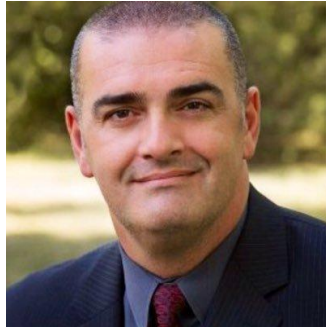

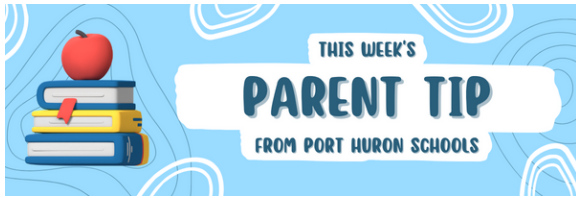

- Students are taught these expectations at the beginning of the school year, after holiday breaks and as needed during the school year.



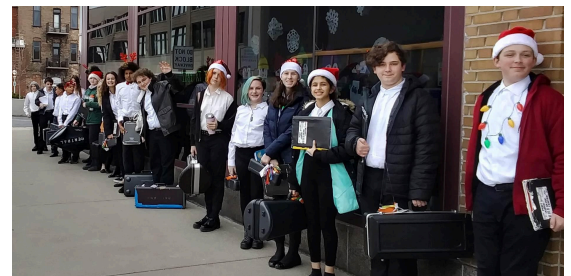

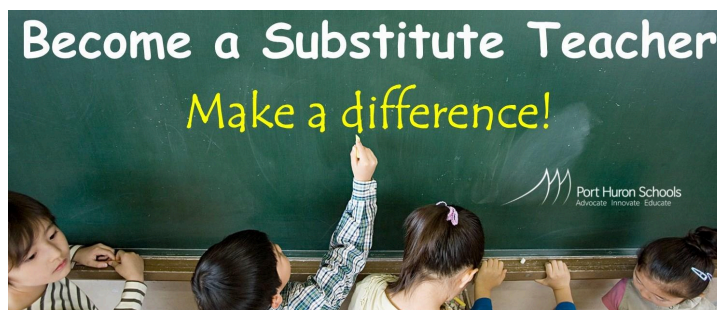
