

WHAT IS MARCH ON WITH MENTOR TEXTS?

March On with Mentor Texts is an adaptation of the now-defunct ReFoReMo (Reading for Research Month). ReFoReMo Founders Kirsti Call and Carrie Charley Brown passed the torch to me in hopes for me to keep the concept alive. March On with Mentor Texts is a re-visioning of that wonderfully helpful picture book community event.

Basically, each day of the month, we will upload a blogpost from an Author, Illustrator, Editor or other kidlit professional. The blogpost will identify and discuss four or five Picture Book Mentor Texts and how they were used or how they can be used to help children's writers further themselves on their publication journey.

HOW DO I SIGN UP FOR MARCH ON WITH MENTOR TEXTS?

You will need to follow the Rate Your Story Blog by going to www.rateyourstory.org/blog and subscribing to the blog in field at the bottom. To be eligible for prizes, you will also need to comment with the requested information in the Registration Post. Thereafter, you will need to read and comment on each and every post. See below.

HOW DO I WIN PRIZES IN MARCH ON WITH MENTOR TEXTS?

FOR REFERENCE: If you go to the bottom of this document there is a listing of all of last year's posts. I am pretty flexible and enjoyed that there were differences between them. But there must be content, reference to mentor texts in some way, take-away value, a prize and your bio and social media.

WHAT SHOULD I, AS A MOWMT FEATURED AUTHOR, INCLUDE IN MY POST?

POST: Your post should be anywhere from 250 – 800 Words and should include 4 Mentor Text examples that tie-in to your subject matter. A fifth Mentor Text could be a tie-in to your own book!

PRIZE: It is also important that you are offering some sort of a prize to bring readers to your post and promote you. This can be a book, a critique, book swag and or a mentoring session!

BIO: Bio limit is 200 Words. NO EXCEPTIONS, please.

AUTHOR HEADSHOT: Attached as a .jpg to your submission post.

BOOK COVERS: Attached as .jpgs to your submission e-mail. The "suggested" placement of each by name should be noted within the manuscript. For example, [Insert: The Palace Rat Cover Here.]

FEATURED BOOK COVER: One of your own books that relates to the topic and can be included in the post. In addition, if you want to include all or the rest of your books, please create a canva banner image with your author photo and books.

SOCIAL MEDIA LINKS: Please include these with your Bio (in your post document). If these are forgotten, the post will go up without them.

PLEASE NOTE: **All MOWMT Posts are due ASAP** as we are behind this year due to my father's illness. Thank you!

IMPORTANT: Please note due to time constraints and other deadlines, bios prizes and social media and such will NOT be added later. So, don't forget any items. If you should forget a prize, I will offer the winner a book of your choice, to be provided by you, the Author. Double-check your submission to make certain you have all the required components (this includes bio, Social Media, Author Headshot, Cover jpegs, etc.). Please

understand the necessity for this request – our first three years were, for the most part, a nightmare of herding cats and incomplete submissions.


