The General Assembly,

Noting the repeated instances in which North Korean missiles have exited their own territory,

*Acknowledging* the increased tensions that these events have caused within East Asia and throughout the world as a whole,

*Drawing attention* to the fact that the launching of missiles into international territory in this region greatly increases the risk of conflict - including nuclear conflict - between states,

Further noting that the launching of missiles into international territory disrupts commerce and poses physical risks to ships, aircraft and the natural environment,

- 1. *Expresses grave concern* that North Korea continues to develop its missile program in such an aggressive fashion despite previous UN condemnations;
- 2. *Strongly requests* that North Korea put into place internal policies prohibiting the firing of missiles into international territory for purposes of testing or power projection, and additionally take measures to ensure that its missiles do not leave its territory even in the event of an unforeseen accident or malfunction;
- 3. *Strongly condemns* the instances in which North Korea has fired missiles into international territory.
