

# MAYOR'S CUP (INDEPENDENCE DAY) REGATTA and combined FIRST DAY OF SUMMER/FALL REGATTA SERIES

On July 1 Lake Merritt Sailing Club hosts four races that will be scored as two regattas. The first is the Mayor's Cup/Independence Day regatta. The Mayor's Cup and other prizes will be awarded that day. The fee for participation in the Mayor's Cup regatta is \$15 per boat.

The second regatta is the first day of the Summer/Fall series to be held July 1, August 12, September 9, and October 14. Prizes for the series will be awarded on October 14. The separate fee for participation in this series is \$15 per boat per day or \$45 per boat for the whole four-day series (no refunds for cancellations).

You must pick the regattas you want to compete in, and pay the entry fee(s) before the start of the first race.

Prizes will be awarded as follows: If three boats are in a class, first place will get a prize. Four boats, first and second boats will get prizes. Five or more boats, first, second, and third place boats will get prizes.

Note that the hoist for launching opens at about 10:30. There is a ramp with minimal dock facilities for launching from trailers.

Starts will be given to any fleet of three or more boats. If necessary there will be a handicap start. Handicap calculations will be based on the U.S. Sailing 2017 North American Portsmouth Yardstick Table of Pre-Calculated Classes.
