Have you ever dreamed about running into burning buildings as a firefighter? You might think that firefighters are only men, but you are WRONG!! We chose this job because we want to be there to help people in their hardest times. We interviewed Elise Guidry from station 2. We drove to the firehouse where Elise was stationed and asked her questions about her job. If you want to be a firefighter, you have to be quick, brave, knowledgeable, and a team player.

The Training Required to be a Firefighter

First, you must have an EMT certification, which is one semester of college. An EMT stands for Emergency Medical Technician. You need that to be able to drive an ambulance. Then, you need to get an IV Certification. An IV is Intravenous therapy, which is administering blood, medicine, water, nutrients, and other fluids directly

into the bloodstream via the veins.

Don't forget "Firemen never die, they just

burn forever in the hearts of the people whose lives they saved," said Susan Diane Murphree.





Why Elise decided to be a firefighter

Elise, then, didn't always want to be a firefighter. She originally envisioned herself being a PO (PO means Police Officer). She did a few rides along with some police officers. She changed her mind when she saw the stuff that the police dealt with. Elise then decided she wanted to be in an ambulance.



"I really want to help people and found out that as an EMT, I could help people live," said Elise.

Math Needed as a Firefighter

In ADDITION (pun so intended) to being an EMT and IV specialist, you need to do some math as a firefighter, according to Elise. However, it is basic math that you will need. It is the math you learn in middle school.

Sometimes, you need to calculate if there's a drug overdose. You also need to use basic math (multiplication, division, etc.). The firefighters also use math to calculate how much water they need from the water pumps to extinguish a fire. You don't need high-level math to be a firefighter, just the basics that you learn



here at Drake. "Math might not be the first thing you consider when weighing the pros and cons of pursuing a career in firefighting, but it's a crucial component in fighting fires and in fighting for a stronger fire department," says Anna Maria College's Admission requirements for firefighting.

Has anyone in your station died and do you all get along?

Thankfully nobody at Elise's station has died a line of duty death (A line of duty death is when someone dies at work or because of work). Jim Schaefer, a firefighter over at station 3 tragically died of cancer (cancer is a disease in which abnormal cells divide uncontrollably and destroy body

tissue).

Everyone on her shift gets along.

They all help each other out. When we were there, an alarm went off and Mr.King,

her supervisor, went instead of Elise so she could talk to us. Mr. King likes helping students because his daughter also goes to Drake!

"We all go shopping for groceries together because we're like a big family," said Elise. "Everyone helps each other out."



How badly have you been burned in a fire? What kind of protection from heat do standard firefighter suits provide?

Elise has gotten lucky and has not been burned in a fire yet. Most of the time when you are watching a TV show with firefighters you see them wearing black gear. You see them walking through the fire wearing the black turnout (A turnout is another name for the gear firefighters wear)

But firefighters try to avoid contact with the fire. They still don't provide 100% protection, you're still going to feel hot and sweaty from the heat. We liked

seeing how they kept their firefighter outfits bundled up on top of their boots so that they could be out the door in 30 seconds.

"They still don't provide 100% protection so you're still going to feel the heat," said Elise.

So, do you think you still want to be a firefighter? With the right education and training, you totally can!

How to Become a Police Officer

Until we had laws, there was no structure in the world. But thanks to the deputies and officers of the world, they enforced laws. We all want to be police officers. We want to help people be safe. We interviewed our SRO (Student Resource Officer) Deputy Gallegos. Before you think about becoming a police officer or Deputy, you should find out if it's a good fit for you.



We just arrived at the Jefferson County Sheriff's office and Deputy Gallegos is meeting us to show us around! We are so excited!

How To Start





First, if you want to become a police officer, you can be a teenager to start their "Explorer Program". You need to be at least 14, and in the 9th grade, but not yet 21 years of age. You have to be currently enrolled in high school, an accredited homeschooling program, or college. You have to keep a grade point average of 2.0 or higher - that means all C's or higher. Passing a background investigation is also part of the process.

You also need to have written permission from a parent/guardian if you are under 18 years of age. You, in addition, need to be of good moral character. Being of good moral character means not getting in trouble in school or with law enforcement. "I like this job because I can help people feel safe both in middle school and out in our community," said Deputy Gallegos.

6 months!!!


After high school, you can then enter the police academy. It takes 6 months to get the job. First, you have to do a 30-page questionnaire, and after they do a polygraph (a lie detector test) based on the 30-page questionnaire to make sure you are not lying.

After that they make you drag a dummy across the room to make sure you are strong enough to do the job.

While learning how to ground fight, it generally takes from one to two months. You also learn how to drive cars fast, without hitting or harming anybody. At the Academy, you learn how to shoot a gun and how to tase someone. Finally, you have to graduate from the 6-month police academy.

First, Deputy Gallegos has a bulletproof vest, a radio, a body cam, a baton, her gun, a control to turn on her body cam, 2 sets of handcuffs, her work phone, 2 extra magazines, her taser, her flashlight, a tourniquet, extra gloves, and finally a

pocket knife. She feels so much lighter when she can be in just her regular uniform at the end of the day! "It all weighs around 30 pounds," said Deputy Gallegos.

The Best Arrest -Olivia

We asked Deputy Gallegos what her best arrest was while we were walking around the station. Deputy Gallegos at first went on call for a suspicious person reported. Then, she met the wife of the man who told Ms. Gallegos that she had been locked in the basement for days and he went as far as boarding up the door so she couldn't get out. The man did go to jail. Deputy Gallegos

felt good about helping that woman be safe once again. "It's a good job if you want to help people," said Deputy Gallegos.

As we walked around, we learned that many officers work there with their families. Officer Gallegos' dad and sister both work at the station. Her dad is a sergeant and her sister works in the jail. Her dad came out to say hi while we were there. "I became a police officer because of my dad," said Officer Gallegos. Another officer who came to Drake to talk to our students was Officer Greaser. Her husband and two sons work there, too. Because they are family, there is lots of fear in the station if someone gets

shot.

Cost of the Uniform - Lilly

Her complete uniform cost about 630 dollars, the rest of the uniform cost nothing, it was free. The item that cost the most was the gun. Police officers have to buy their gun. The other thing you have to buy is your boots. The boots are about 20 dollars. The gun costs about 600 dollars you may be wondering what the other 10 dollars went to, well it went to tax so it is about 630 dollars! The rest is

provided by the police station so it does cost money but it won't cost as much money if you had to buy your whole uniform. "My Glock 17 was pretty expensive at 600 dollars," said Deputy Gallegos. The new woman sheriff, Reggie Marinelli, is trying to get lighter uniforms.

How Long For An Arrest? ~Lilly

It usually takes about three days to make an arrest. It all depends on what facts they have on the case and how close they are to solving the

mystery behind the crime. It all depends on the crime, too. If they have a warrant, they can find you and arrest you. The most important part is that people are safe. That might mean you spend time in jail until you get to see a judge, or someone can bail you out. If you get a sentence of 12-18 months, then you go to a different prison to serve your sentence. It can be hard sometimes because you are always at risk of getting shot," said Deputy Gallegos.





The majority of car salesman salaries currently range between \$12.64/hour in Colorado. Importantly, most Tesla sales jobs are paid

almost \$100,000 dollars a year which is more than the average car salesman. "I think it is possible for ordinary people to choose to be extraordinary." \sim Elon Musk

salesperson. A fact about Tesla is Tesla's Roadster was the first production electric car to use lithium-ion battery cells. They almost die in BUDS (Basic Underwater Demolition/SEAL Training) and then almost drown in their desire to become a SEAL. We both like hunting, swimming, and fishing. This will all help us in the U.S. Navy SEALS because they are always outside all the time! To become

a Navy Seal, you have to be mentally and physically strong.

The First Steps to Becoming a Navy Seal

Joining the Navy, to begin with, requires a test and time. In high school, you will take the ASVAB test, which is the Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery. The score you need to get to join the Navy Seals is 220 or higher. You need to have a high school diploma or GED (General Educational Development). The higher the score on the ASVAB test, the more doors open for your career in the Navy and life. "It pays to be a winner," said

Keola Bandmann. "I scored high, so they were knocking at my door to join the nuclear unit."

 Meet the minimum Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery (ASVAB) score: GS+MC+EI=170 or VE+MK+MC+CS=220 or VE+AR=110 MC=50

There are a lot of jobs in the U.S.

Navy that you might enjoy depending on your score. Only a few people try to be in the SEALS. Not a lot of people make it through the first month or the training itself. Yet no one knows what kind of people get in the training and make it out. 20% try for the SEALS, still, 75% to 85% drop out, and only 10% get in the Navy SEALS. That is a small number of people in the whole Navy very few maybe like 2 or 3 out of 10 people make it in and the others drop out.

The Drown Proof Test Scary or Fun (the Seal Water Challenge Test)

This test, therefore, is where they tie your hands and legs together and they throw you in the water. You have to go get your goggles that they threw in the water for you. Due to the difficulty and stressful nature of this task, some people pass out during the test and some almost drown.

While in high school, I'm going to do well. Mr. Bandmann said it starts in middle school though with good work habits and workout habits. Throughout the four years, I will be researching the information that matters for the Navy Seals and getting stronger. By running, and doing lots of pull-ups and sit-ups, I will be training my body for the SEALS. Then I will join the Navy and stay strong through training and all the schooling.

got my answers from Google. I didn't go anywhere as I was supposed to be out of town. Although I didn't go I still had fun figuring out answers to my dream job, and I would still be a vet.

Education to be a vet

First, vets have to do a lot of years of college. I learned that vets have to take

8-10 years of college; they also have to be 20 - 40+ years old if they want to work. Why people have to

take 8-10 years of college is because they need to learn how to do surgeries. It would be very dangerous to not know what you're doing. Why you have to be 20 or

40+ is because if you're younger you have to be in school and at 19 it would be too soon and you have to take 8-10 years of college. It would be crazy if you worked at 9 years old.

"Veterinary school takes a long time because it takes time to learn everything you need to know to successfully work with the animals performing surgeries, administering treatments, and interacting with clients," said Google.

Surgery and Babies

Another important part to being a great vet is to not be afraid to do whatever it takes to save the animal. One of the grossest parts is flushing maggots out of a dog's intestine. If you aren't able to do these, the dog might die. I also wonder how would a vet take the babies out if they were stuck. The vet will deliver them by Cesarean section. This means they cut the dog's womb open and take out the



babies. Also, they first have to give them a medical treatment. After that the mom can still nurse and care for her newborns

"Flushing maggots out of a dog's vulva and squishing giant warble larvae out of lumps in the skin requires the vet to not be afraid," said Google.

How Vets Keep Their Patients Safe and Calm

Second is how vets do when pets can't sit still or get out of control. When the dog or cats are out of control, the vets have to be very cautious when handling that animal because the dog could bite and the cat could scratch. Why dogs or cats don't want to go into the room is because of past traumatic experiences at the vet. They don't like shots either. Also when some vet tries to get the dogs or cats in they might push them and scold them. When a dog or a cat doesn't want to

go in the room, some of the vets use different techniques, such as talking nicely or treats along the way. "This could be due to a past traumatic experience or negative association with the room, such as being punished or scolded in that space," said Google.

Sickness and surgery

Next, how does a vet know what to do when a dog or cat is sick or how it passes away from anesthesia?

About one in 1,000 healthy cats die and about one of 2,000 dogs die from anesthesia each year. How they check what sickness a dog has is the blood work. They also do X-rays to check what illnesses they have. You also have to take your

time in checking them up.

The dog has anesthesia

"Blood work is the most common type of diagnostic testing that veterinarians perform," said Google.

Dogs and Infections

Finally, how do vets know what kind of infection they have and their age? When a dog has an infection, they have to run tests with the skin cytology, scraping, and hair plucking. Canine puppies under one year of age are susceptible to gastrointestinal infections and acute diarrhea. That means they can get infections in their guts that can

cause bad diarrhea. "Canine puppies under one year of age are highly susceptible to gastrointestinal infections. Acute diarrhea is one of the most common clinical manifestations, potentially leading to severe dehydration and death," said Google.

The average shop owner will typically warranty their repairs for one year or 12,000 miles, and if a part fails after that first year, they will tell their customers that they will do the repair at a discounted rate. Also, labor warranties typically cover the cost of labor to correct any issues that arise due to faulty workmanship within a certain timeframe, such as 30, 60, or 90 days.
