❖ Official Transcripts*

Minimum GPA Requirement

GPA must be 2.75 in the last 60 semester units completed or 2.5 cumulative.

Certificate of Clearance from the Commission on Teacher Credentialing

- □ Upload a copy of your Certificate of Clearance with your application. Please do not upload your Live Scan Form (41-LS) with your application— you.
 - ➤ This requires a 2-step process. Please anticipate up to a month for this process to clear: Certificate of Clearance Instructions

❖ Tuberculosis (TB) Clearance

- ☐ Upload a copy of your Negative TB test result. The TB Risk Assessment Questionnaire is not accepted for the credential program. A negative TB result must be current for the duration of the credential program. TB results are valid for 4 years
 - Your document must include 1) Your first and last name, 2) the facility, 3) date the test was administered, and 3) the date the result was read (for skin tests).

❖ One Letter of Recommendation

☐ Phase I applicants must provide ONE letter of recommendation at the time of their initial application and the second letter by the time of the Phase II application

Recommendation letters are not uploaded by applicants— there is a process configured via the Cal State Apply application system: <u>Letters of</u> <u>Recommendation Instructions & Requirements</u>.
