COURSE: *German 1*

COURSE CURRICULUM

COURSE DESCRIPTION: Students in this beginning level course will start to develop skills in written and oral communication. Technology and materials incorporate a variety of sources and include native speakers and writers from a number of target language countries. Students will begin to develop conversational skills. They will begin studying aspects of the target culture, such as art, music, and daily life, and learn to compare their native culture with the culture of the target language. The target language will be used throughout the course, and the students will be encouraged to use the target language to communicate with their teacher and peers.

- How is my school schedule similar or different to a German school?
- How do I spend my day?

- What responsibilities do I have after school?
