A minimum numeric course average of 65% is required to earn course credit, regardless of the diploma a student chooses to pursue.

To qualify for a Scholar’s Diploma, a student must:

- Meet the credit requirements outlined above.
- Maintain a cumulative numerical average of at least 88% throughout his/her high school career.

**Please note:** Students taking two or more Advanced Placement courses will be given special consideration for the Scholars Diploma, even if they do not meet all of the elective course criteria. The upper school principal has the discretion to approve other courses of study to meet the criteria of the Scholars diploma.
