



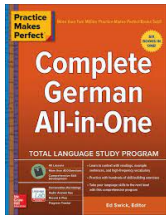

- Look up the unknown words in the Wortschatz section at the end of the book (alphabetically organized).

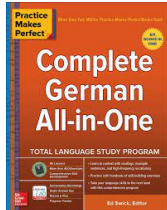
- Record yourself reading the chapter and insert the audio link in the assignment
