Celebrating the Class of 2025

Lisgar will be celebrating the Class of 2025 with two official events: the Prom on June 13th at the Château Laurier and the Commencement Ceremony on June 27th at Adult High School. Events and fundraisers not associated with Prom or Commencement have not been sanctioned by the school or the OCDSB. This includes after-parties and other private functions that are not supervised by OCDSB staff. Parents and guardians are encouraged to ask questions of their graduates to ensure all celebrations are safe, respectful, and supportive of good citizenship.

All students are reminded that Friday June 13th is a regular instructional day that may include important end-of-year evaluation tasks assigned by teachers. Students are expected to be present as per their assigned timetable. Lisgar Welcomes Japanese Exchange Students

For two action-packed weeks in April, Lisgar students opened their homes and classrooms to 18 students from the <u>Yamate Gakuin Senior High School</u> in Yokohama, Japan. Our Japanese visitors experienced the Ontario education system, took part in extracurricular activities, including an outdoor education excursion, and shared aspects of their own culture with the Lisgar community. In July 2025, our Canadian students will travel to Japan to complete this year's very successful reciprocal exchange. Students participating in the exchange will receive credit towards their <u>International Certificate</u>.



Did you know...

Lisgar's attic was once used as a shooting range during the First World War. In 1912, a rifle range was added to the now-blocked-off fifth-floor attic for the school's cadet corps. Students practiced shooting there until after World War II, when shooting activities moved to the nearby Cartier Square Drill Hall.
