Doing well with Goals. Second set of Data.

Literacy: Gathering Reading Levels and Writing samples.

Math: Number of the Day: doing well with this strategy.

Questions asked: how is Math pull out intervention helping? Is the reading of the problems affecting math scores? How is attendance helping goals. Are we consistent with math vocabulary for assessment when we teach?

Reading: our kids are not willing to take chances.

P-3 Literacy: We have a large divide of students who are achieving a lot and very poorly. Why is this?

3-5 Literacy: are Running Records accurate? Results should include LD diagnosis and IPP

P-2 Math: not getting enough support.

Grades 3-5 scores 80% or higher. Is this carrying over to other strands.

Resource Model: is it working?
