Other questions not answered at the Forum.

Question: Extended Essay: Can the school clarify who are the advisors and on what basis are they chosen?

Response: Advisors for Extended Essays must be an employee from ISB. It is preferred that this person has expertise in the subject area, but more importantly, they have expertise in the process of conducting academic research. Faculty members volunteer and advisors are allocated on a best-fit basis, dependent on student choices of subjects.

Question: Chaperones on School trips: For school trips is it typical for participating students to pay for a second chaperone?

Response: Yes - for school trips the cost of the chaperones is split amongst the students who are participating. This is true for one, two or more chaperones on a trip.

Question: Summer and Winter Camps: Can ISB organise camps during the summer or winter breaks?

Response: ISB does not organise camps, but the Community Activities office does disseminate information about summer and winter camps as they come to hand. ISB does run summer school programs and you will hear more about that in the second semester.

Question: ISB Email account: Is it possible for students to keep their ISB email account after graduation or transfer?

Response: We are currently looking into this possibility with our tech office and alumni relations to see if we can provide access to graduating and departing students.

Question: Vending machines selling energy drinks: Can the school remove these?

Response: Currently reviewing this with our building and grounds staff and athletics office.
