The Projects Portal is the one-stop destination for students to view and apply to projects offered by the faculties.


#### **Accessing Projects Portal**

Projects Portal


On the left hand side, you can see three subcategories

- a) Eligible Projects
- b) My Applications
- c) My Projects

These categories will be explained in greater detail in the upcoming sections of the manual

## Applying for a Project

The **Eligible Projects** view shows all the projects the particular user is **eligible** to apply for. The eligibility criteria is decided by the Faculty who proposes the project itself and not by IRIS Team.




Eligible Projects

Every project card contains two buttons, **View** and **Apply.** The view button will expand the project's card to display additional information about the project.




Expanded Project Card

On clicking the **Apply** button ( either on the project card or expanded project card), the user will be redirected to a page where he/she has to fill out their application for the project.




Project Application Page

Once the application is filled, the user can click on the **Apply** button at the bottom of the page to submit their application



### Viewing Application Status


The user can view the status of his/her applications in the **My Applications** view.



In this view, the user can see all their applications and the status of the application as well. They can also review their application using the **Show** button corresponding to each application.

#### All Projects
