2. POSTING GUIDANCE

During the Week of Action, we'll create a powerful nationwide chorus of support for offshore wind while showcasing the real momentum happening in our communities.

- When: Monday, November 17 Sunday, November 23, 2025
- Goal: Unite behind #YesToWind hashtag and brand, while keeping your local authentic voice.

Posting Requirements:

- Aim to post at least 3x during the Week of Action
- Use **#YesToWind** and tag local partners
- Include branded Yes to Wind graphics from the toolkit
- Combine branded content with photos/videos from your state and regional events
 - show real people, real support, real momentum
- Share and comment on partner posts to amplify reach

Make It Local:

Where relevant, add your community's specific context to each post:

- Name local projects, ports, or job numbers
- Reference your state's energy costs or climate goals
- Tag local unions, partners or community groups
- Feature photos and videos from your Week of Action events!!

Best Practices:

- Post during peak times (typically morning or evening local time)
- Encourage staff and partners to share from personal accounts to reach more community members outside of industry followers
- Track engagement (likes, comments, etc.) so we can demonstrate our impact!

4. DIGITAL AMPLICATION COORDINATED ACTIONS

Action #1: Coordinated Message Launch

Copy / Caption:

Today we kick off the #YesToWind National Week of Action! Offshore wind means good-paying American jobs, reliable power, and more affordable energy for our communities. Join us as we celebrate what offshore wind makes possible. Will you say #YesToWind? https://oceantic.org/oceantic-event/yes-to-wind/

On Monday morning, every participating group will post the same shared image and caption across their social channels to create a unified, high-impact visual moment. By flooding feeds with the same graphic at around the same time—and tagging or inviting each other to collaborate—we amplify the message, signal national alignment, and build momentum for the rest of the Week of Action.

How to Participate:

- Post the shared image on Monday morning (10AM EST / 7AM PST)
- Tag partner organizations or send a collaboration request where possible.
- Use the shared caption (you can adapt it to match your voice.)
- Link to Oceantic landing page

Action #2 - Collect throughout the week - Post after

A short video of event attendees answering the same question, supercut of clips from events across states. Ask that during events throughout the week folks pull aside attendees and record them giving a short answer to a question. It's important that everyone is answering the same question and it's short because this will be cut together. Each clip will include the organization and state tag at the bottom, and we'll share a unified final video that everyone can co-post. See examples of a supercut style video from Future Earth or

Prompt/Question to ask:

- Why do you support offshore wind?
- Share one reason you support offshore wind

Script:

"Hi! We're putting together a short video made up of clips from events happening all across the country for this Yes to Wind Week of Action. Everyone is asking the same question, and we'll be sharing the final video on social media after. Would you be open to answering one quick question on camera?"

(If they say yes):

"Great! In one short sentence, can you tell me **why you support offshore wind?** No wrong answers, just keep it honest to what's important to you. Can you also please begin by stating your name and organization if relevant."

Recording Tips:

- Keep clips to 5–15 seconds per person.
- Film in **vertical** format with clear audio (step away from wind/noise).
- Frame just the person that is answering the question head-on.
- Take notice of the background (make sure you're not like next to a trash can).
- Capture a mix of perspectives from jobs to costs to climate.

We want to create two live digital activations to gather, engage, and inform our audiences (and beyond!) on how offshore wind is an important clean energy resource that benefits American families, lowers our energy bills and reduces air pollution. Clean, healthy and abundant!

Action #3 – Bluesky Live: Monday, November 17th at 2pm

A Bluesky informal 45 minute threaded convo on Monday, November 17th at 2pm EST. This conversation will kick off our Week of Action with all participating organizations to do the following:

- 1) In clear, everyday language explain the power of wind
- 2) Your organization's event in detail why this event, how people can RSVP
- 3) Drive ongoing action by inviting people to sign the petition on <u>yestowind.com</u> or your link

Climate Action Rhode Island will lead the conversation and will invite engagement from other organizations or key figures. The goal is to spark engagement across accounts, boost each other's events, and create a lively thread that highlights shared messaging in a fun, collaborative way.

Action #4 - Instagram Live: Wednesday, November 19th at TBD

Similar to the Bluesky idea, except we will be live on Instagram. This will be a midweek Instagram live for 30 minutes on how offshore wind benefits Americans from all walks of life, why we need each of us to speak up for offshore wind, how to take action for offshore wind this week and beyond, and take a few minutes to refute one or two myths on offshore wind. NE4OSW will lead this live.
