Homework: Googlehack

A Googlehack is an online contest, first seen in 2002, where searchers attempt to find two words that can be used as part of a search engine query that results in only one hit.

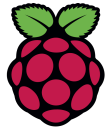
The words must be found in the English dictionary and you cannot use advanced search operators. It sounds easy, but it's not. For example, 'magenta banana' as a search term gives you 135,000,000 results.

Record five attempts in the table below, along with the number of results:

It is likely you haven't been successful. Try again, but this time you are allowed to use the search operators OR, NOT (-), and phrase searches (" ").
