Joseph Hoffman – Dr. Joseph Hoffman received his medical training in Internal Medicine at Yale University School of Medicine, where he completed post-doctoral fellowships in Pulmonary Diseases and Critical Care Medicine, and later received training as a research fellow in Medical Oncology. Following appointments to the Yale faculty as an Associate Research Scientist and Attending Physician in the Yale Comprehensive Cancer Center Lung Cancer Unit, Dr. Hoffman joined Roche Pharmaceuticals as a clinical research physician. During his more than 20 years at Roche, Dr. Hoffman served in a number of senior leadership positions including Vice President of the Virology Pharma Development group during which time breakthrough therapies for human immunodeficiency, hepatitis C and influenza A viruses were approved for human use, and Global Head of Oncology Safety Sciences responsible for overseeing risk-management for the industry-leading Roche-Genentech Oncology portfolio. Since retiring from Roche-Genentech in 2013, Dr. Hoffman has served as a consultant to multiple pharmaceutical companies and has contributed to the evaluation of more than two dozen treatments for serious diseases including cancers, hepatic failure, anthrax infection, sarcoidosis and graft-versus-host disease.

Christophe Bommier – Christophe is the Chief Technology Officer & Group VP-Research at Mersen SA and is one of the few world's leading experts in the field of graphite. He has dedicated his career to research and innovation in the field of graphite and has accompanied all the 21st century technological innovations through his activity.
