

Lesson 4: Easter Series

Topic: Miracle of Christ (Raising Lazarus from Dead)

Age: 1-3

Objective: At the end of the lesson, the children will be able to understand that raising Lazarus from the dead is a miracle.

They will be able to have an idea of what Jesus is able to do

Martha did not understand.

removed from the tomb.

Jesus prayed and then called
out, "Lazarus, come out!"

Lazarus walked out of the
cave alive.

Everyone was amazed, and
many believed in Jesus.

1. What is the name of Mary and Martha's brother? (Lazarus)
2. How many days was Lazarus dead? (4 days)
3. Who raised him from the dead? (Jesus)
