Simple Syllabus is a cloud-based application designed to help faculty, staff and students easily access, edit and manage their syllabi in a single location. To access your Simple Syllabus, login to your Canvas course and find the link on the left side navigation. Alternatively, you can go directly to the website at usfca.simplesyllabus.com

Faculty members can benefit from using a customizable template according to their school/college.

The template includes auto-populated content, such as university policies, course description, accessibility resources and the course schedule with the exact meeting dates of each class throughout the semester.

A faculty member can add additional components to provide more information specific to each course. All components can be added as a navigation item on the left side of the page to make it easy for students to locate information within the syllabus. The navigation also can be reordered based on a faculty member's preferences.

Staff members such as program assistants will no longer need to ask for syllabi if they are given access to the Simple Syllabus library.

Students can see all of their syllabi in one place and get a quick list of the required textbooks and materials for easy preparation.

Students can also view other course syllabi through the syllabus library and get a preview of what other courses offer prior to registering for them.

Faculty can decide which components are visible in the library for others to view.

Simple Syllabus provides a syllabus repository that can benefit all participating members through the use of standardized templates, auto-populated policies and opportunities to observe student participation in an effort to better support their academic success.
