Project Description / Scope:

This project provides funding for HSU campus departments/areas/offices that have completed a Green Workplace Assessment with the student group Green campus. Money is intended to fund energy efficient equipment that Green Campus identifies as being outdated or in need of replacement in order to achieve energy savings and energy efficiency. Qualifying projects may be funded up to \$1,500 per department with a summative funding allocation capping out at \$20,000.

Committee funding allocation dictates that IT or other appropriate entities must specify qualifying equipment, that HEIF Project Manager should ensure HEIF can fund each project, and that every two years HEIF should review and re-examine projects (meaning that each individual project does not need to come before the Committee but that at two year milestones the Committee would ensure implemented projects are within intended scope and magnitude and adjust funding and scope as needed).


