Prop 41: two different opinions

- Yes. We need to support our veterans. Redirects \$600 million of previously approved, unspent bond funds to construct and rehabilitate housing for California's large population of homeless veterans.
- No: Handing out homes will not address root causes of homeless veterans. Federal level assistance should be explored. Too much burden to taxpayers already. 这是联邦层次的问题, 不应有州来管。州一级加税, 由于政府的腐败, 真正到老兵手的会很少。并且, 如果投yes, 会导致全美没有此类政策的州的老兵, 都移到加州。加州付的起吗? 那只能加州再加税。这些房子盖哪里? 如果加州政府决定在每个好学区内建一片廉租房, 治安会如何? Howard Jarvis taxpayers association members did the analysis and changed the position to No! Veteran bonds provide low interest mortgage loans to veterans. These bonds are repaid by the veterans themselves. Props 41 bonds will be used to construct low income housing and costs will be paid by state taxpayers. Vote no on props 41.

Prop 42: Yes. Reason: transparency law for local government

County

Alameda: AA, No. measure AA Healthcare Services Sales Tax: renew the same 0.5% sales tax increase until 2034. Sales tax is already too high. We don't want to keep the increase for another 20-year! Also there is **NO annual fiscal oversight and review** for this!

The description of the measure in the ballot is **very misleading**. It is to extend a 0.5% sale tax increase for another 20 years. But the description is carefully engineered to hide this by saying "without increasing the existing half-cent sales and use tax, ... shall the county extend this measure until June 2034 without annual fiscal oversight/review?" Now the measure reads like no tax increase! there is **no accountability**. (See Ordinance, C&D.) And not surprisingly, a huge hunk of the Tax money is given away to the wealthy non-profit hospitals who support these Tax Measures with their large campaign contributions. Children's Hospital alone, recently shelled out over \$2 million in campaign contributions.

Contra Costa: E, NO
