Speaker's Character: Oliver

(Key jingling sounds, door to home opening and closing)

Oliver: (Back turned to Listener, pouring some liquid into cups sounds) Hey Sweetie. Glad you made it home. I heard that there was a bad accident on the highway. I just finished making some orange juice that I wanted you to try. (Turns around to face Listener, very concerned) Love...what happened? You look exhausted. Your eyes show some sadness too.

(Listener responds)

(Listener responds)

Oliver: Mmm...I see. The copy machine was needed for a lot of your work today. Was someone able to call a technician to take a look at the machine?

(Listener responds)

Oliver: Okay. Well, at least your coworker was able to get a hold of someone. When did they make it in to fix the machine?

(Listener responds)

Oliver: (Shocked) What?! It took 4 hours for someone to come in and fix the machine?

(Listener responds)

Oliver: (Disappointed) Ah. It is too bad that they couldn't fix the machine. Will they be getting a new one soon?

(Listener responds)

Oliver: Did they say how long it will take for the new machine to come in?

(Listener responds)

Oliver: (Shocked) Seriously?! It'll take two weeks for the machine to come in?! (Disappointed) Darn. It just sounds like your office has to rely heavily on it. What will all of you be doing then?

(Listener responds)

(Listener responds)

Oliver: They don't have much of a choice though since your copy machine doesn't work and it was the only one you have. Your office is pretty small in size so it's not like there's much room for another machine anyway.

(Listener responds)

Oliver: Hopefully these two weeks will go fast so that the machine can come in. (Concerned) I still feel a lot of tension from you. What else happened at work today Love?

(Listener responds)

Oliver: (Shocked) The phones went down too?! (A little relieved) Good thing your coworker called when they did for that tech since the phones went down after that. (Disappointed) Technology sounded like it didn't want to work very well today.

(Listener responds)

Oliver: Did you have a lot of phone calls to make?

(Listener responds)

Oliver: (Sighing) That is tough. You said they only went down for a couple of hours. At least they weren't down for the whole day. Were you and everyone able to get most of the calls done?

(Listener responds)

Oliver: Well, good. It's hard that all of you just barely made all the calls needed today, but at least they're all done now.

(Listener responds)

Oliver: (Showing concern again) I still feel that more happened to you at work today Love. Your eyes tell me so and your shoulders are tense. Go sit down on the couch and I'll bring over the orange juice. Then, you can tell me what else happened okay Sweetheart?

(Listener responds)

(Oliver goes into the kitchen and picks up the cups. Comes back to where Listener is)

(Listener responds)

Oliver: (Comforting) Love, don't doubt yourself. I know you can do this. You can put your mind to something and work hard at it. I know it's not easy to wire your thinking to be more positive about yourself or situations, but you can do it. I believe in you and I know you'll succeed.

(Listener responds)

Oliver: (Continued comfort) You are more than what you believe you are. I know you are. You're a worthwhile person. You are the most wonderful girlfriend that any boyfriend could ever ask for. If I have to keep reminding you of that, I will. You're never alone. You always have me by your side.

(Listener responds)

Oliver: You know what else? You do so well with comforting me on my hard days. I want to comfort you for your hard days too. It's only fair to reciprocate after all. You always get so goofy when you comfort me. Your silly expressions never fail to make me laugh. (Chuckling) You're so cute!

(Listener responds)

Oliver: (Smiling) I'm glad you're feeling much better now Sweetheart. (Places a gentle kiss to Listener's forehead) I love you Darling. Would you like to watch a show and we can order in your favorite food?

(Listener responds)
