

WMS Football procedures for games on 9/12/20 VS Glasgow:

The GUSB voted this week to allow player households to attend activities for the WMS athletics. All athletes' local household family members (everyone living in the same house) are invited to attend in person. Players were shown their school information and the students added family household members not listed in our school system. We should have everyone on our rosters who may attend.

Attendees:

Local families are asked to check in through the west gate (N. Kendrick) by the announcers booth. A ticket taker/administrator will ask who your child participating is and will check off who is in attendance from that household.

Two tickets for opposing team athletes were given for out of town spectators to attend. These were emailed to the athletic director in Glasgow earlier this week. They will be entering through the NE gate (N Merrill) and will sit on the opposite (East side) sideline behind their team. Bleachers have been moved there to accommodate (more will be coming for future games). Anyone entering the facility must have a ticket in their possession.

WMS students are allowed to attend the games as well as WMS school staff and Glendive Booster Club officers.

At this time, there will be no local general admission spectators or concessions.

Cost of Attendance:

Cost of attendance for WMS games is \$3 for adults/high school students & \$1 for WMS/elementary students. If students have purchased a middle school activity ticket for another sport, they may attend by showing that ticket at the gate. We will also have a roster of people who have purchased activity tickets in case they haven't received their printed one yet.

Spectator Expectations:

All people in attendance must have a face covering when entering the facility and when moving around in the facility. When spectators sit down and are able to maintain social distancing, they will be allowed to remove their face covering. Lastly, all WMS students attending must wear face coverings when not sitting with their family group.
