

#### Morning Arrival

- All students should not arrive earlier than 8:50 am (unless your child is in Kid's Club or is joining to eat breakfast at 8:30 am).
- All students line-up outside unless the windchill is 20 degrees or below. Please make sure your child dresses appropriately.

#### Outdoor Recess

- Students should wear shoes that are appropriate and safe for playing. We recommend sneakers.
   Sandals should be closed-toe with a strap on the heel.
- Students are expected to go outside unless the windchill is 20 degrees or below. Please make sure your child brings hats/gloves/jacket and (snow boots and snow pants if they want to play in the snow). We recommend you

label all items on the inside of clothing/item.
