If coms are open, or you are preparing to grab a slot. You will eventually need to satisfy all of the following- read carefully and keep in mind that if any of this is not filled out or there is great difficulty in obtaining any of this the com will be rejected.

You may ask me to hold you a slot before providing information if you do not yet have it. I will hold the slot until I find that you fail to provide the following information or your characters do not satisfy my standard requirements.

1. Character refs, names, and roles?

- If body type is different from ref, describe how.
- If outfit is different from ref, describe how.
- ^ (Provide images+descriptors for outfits)

2. Describe each panel in basic terms.

- Make sure to specify whether the panel is half/mini/full
- Start by covering actions being done by the characters.
- Include expressions and dialogue for each relevant panel.
- If you have an angle in mind provide basic description/ref.

3. Provide details for payment.

- Provide e-mail for paypal invoice.
- (invoice won't be sent until proposal is agreed upon)
- * Payment must be provided in full before work is started.
- * Payment can't be delayed more than 5 business days.
- * Payment may be delayed until work is soon to begin if desired.

All additional fees are charged per appearance, per panel- I.E- it costs 40\$ to add a full size character to 1 full size full render panel, but 80\$ to add them to 2 full size full render panels

COMMISSION RULES

- *All characters must be 18+ if displayed in or relating to NSFW material.
- *Characters without a definite age may be rejected.
- *Characters who could potentially be seen as underage may be rejected.
- *Characters who are underage will not be aged up.
- *Payment must be up front.
- *Commissioners must be 18+
- *Commission requests must be approved and may be rejected for ANY reason.

(Read the final proposal I sent w/price estimate **very carefully**, I have a tendency to reword and restate any proposals sent to me. If something gets lost in translation and you still make the payment I consider this an agreement to complete the piece based on the proposal I sent, rather than any initial proposal that was sent to me.)

Significant changes to a piece after final render will only be done if I find it was a mistake on my part. Or the request is a reasonable one. Typically I will not offer significant alterations of a piece even if offered extra cash on top, so please do not expect this.

If you spot a mistake more than 1 week after approval I will not make changes for free and am not obligated to do changes for payment. <u>Please review your commission carefully.</u>

EX: I colored the eyes wrong. This is reasonable and would be changed.

EX: Angle unspecified- but requested changed after completion. This will not be changed.

THINGS I WON'T DRAW

- Extremely detailed sexual cruelty. (think visibly upset/non-willing/screaming victims)
- Bestiality
- Same-Size Vore
- Underage Characters (covered in commission rules)
- IRL People (without explicit reasonable permission)
- Other privately owned OC's (without explicit permission) EX: V-tubers.
- non-human genitalia
- visible scat/piss

FURRY STUFF

- Fair warning: Furry art 'may' be lower quality than non-furry due to my lack of experience with various head types, fur rendering, etc. but I'll give it my best shot.
- I draw MOST furry/scalie species.
- I will typically refuse Horse/Pony/Bird/Avian species.
- I do not draw feral/animal specific genitalia (knots/sheathes and things of that sort)
- All furry/scalie characters should be mostly anthro. (This extends primarily to body types of

large/main characters, and is a bit more flexible for tiny characters. If you're not sure send me a note/DM with your questions.)

REFUND POLICY: A refund will be delivered if I am unable to complete your piece, refunds may only be requested in the middle of completing a piece and may be denied if reasons are unsatisfactory or simply lacking. If I have not yet started your piece you may also request a refund. I am typically lenient with this policy within reason.

QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

What is a commission slot? - Commission slots indicate your position in priority in relation to other commissions. Commission slots are first come first serve. Holding a spot means you're getting a piece from me. Your position on the list represents your priority to me. If you're at the bottom- expect a wait- if you're at or near the top- expect work and contact about your piece frequently.

How do I know if commissions are open? - I will announce when commission slots are opening via post on DA/FA/Twitter. The posts will mention how many slots are opening- on what day- and at what time. Times will be relative to EST - Eastern Standard Time so please keep that in mind! - If a commission slot is still available after the initial opening time has passed I will make those slots visible in this commission journal- they will be indicated by a number and a -EMPTY SLOT-designation.

So a slot is open, how do I get it? - When a slot is available send me a note/message that lets me know that you want the slot and give me as much info as you can about your commission. The important thing is that I know in general what characters are involved and what is roughly happening in the piece so that I can decide if I'm able to take it and hold you a slot.

I've got a slot, now what?- Once you have a commission slot and we have settled on details I will send you an invoice for the cost of the commission. Once you have paid that invoice you've officially got a slot. I will begin work on your commission as soon as you come up on my list- and send you a sketch of your piece as soon as I can. You can request changes at this point- or approve it. Once sketch is approved I will move to linework and then final render asking for the same approval or minor changes.

Can I post your piece now that it's done?- Once I've finished your piece and you've given me the final approval I will either post it myself- or post a censored version if it's too risky for DA. I prefer my commissioners hold off on posting their pieces of mine until I do- however, if you've commissioned piece- you are welcome to share it early wherever you'd like. The only thing I ask when you post my pieces is that you credit me and don't submit them to GiantessBooru (To avoid double posting since I post the piece there myself).
