Students may choose to use results from this free exam to submit to colleges when applying or may choose to register to take the test again individually through www.collegeboard.org. Mundelein High School is offering a variety of support options to assist our students to prepare for the SAT.

- **FREE SAT Prep offered by The MHS Literacy Center and Math Lab:**

- Students can obtain SAT practice tests in the Literacy Center. Students can schedule a time with Literacy Center and Math Lab specialists for support with practice exams.

- **Online Resources**

- [Khan Academy SAT prep](https://www.khanacademy.org/sat-prep)- College Board partners with Khan Academy to provide personalized test results that are paired with a study plan tailored to your individual test results. For example, when your scores are reported you will also find statements about your strengths and weaknesses and content like videos and practice problems to help you improve. Use your personal email to register.
- Collegeboard.org- College Board is the organization that administrates the PSAT and SAT Tests. You should use your personal email address when you register to ensure your scores are reported and shared accurately. Scores from the PSAT and SAT will be shared to your account prior to the mailed scores and contain more score detail. If you have taken an Advanced Placement test, you already have a College Board account.
 - SAT practice tests: 6 free full-length online practice tests.
 - Instant Practice Test scoring app: Take a complete SAT practice test (through collegeboard.org) and use a smartphone to scan your answer sheet and receive an immediate score.
