Respect and Responsibility For Ourselves, Others, and Our School

Expectations:

Beginning of class:

1. Come to class on time with all materials
2. Greet teacher and look him/her in the eye
3. Check board for beginning of class instructions
4. If applicable, take out last night's homework

During class:

1. Wait quietly for today's instructions
2. Limit side talking with friends
3. Stay "on task" in group work
4. Challenge yourself and be willing to learn from mistakes
5. Participate actively in class, both verbally and in writing
6. Respect others' ideas, airtime, and property
7. Raise your hand when you want to speak in class
8. Put the materials given out in class in the correct binder section
9. Tuck backpacks away to keep the aisles clear in case of emergency

End of class/school:

1. Wait for a teacher to signal time to clean up
2. Push in your chair at the end of class
3. Clean up materials
4. A teacher dismisses you, not the bell

Policies:

Books

- You should always have an independent reading book in your homeroom.
- All textbooks and materials should be brought to class each day and kept inside your backpack

Absences

- It is your responsibility to make up all missed work. Check the House S website AND Google Classroom to keep up with work as you are able. The day you return to school, pick up handouts, and plan to stay after and check in with your teachers as soon as possible to turn in assignments and make up missed work. Teachers do not prepare work in advance for absences.

Bathroom Privilege

- Go in between classes or at lunch.
- If it is urgent... wait until the lesson has been presented to ask permission from the teacher and sign out.
- One person at a time.
