Introduction to College Instructors

Introduction to College is a core class that Mount Tamalpais College (MTC) students are required to take in their first semester. Course topics range from targeted study strategies (note-taking, study skills, time management) to academic skill building (emotional self-regulation, learning styles, education planning). This course meets once a week for two hours and requires an educator who is adept at building trust in the classroom and at engaging adult learners. We especially invite Introduction to College instructors who have:

- A Bachelor's degree or higher, preferably in Education, Psychology, Counseling, or Social Work.
- Professional experience in student services or student affairs is a plus.
- Experience working with adult learners is a plus.
