Title 1 Parent Presentation Last year, we met our achievement goals! Fast Bridge screeners to see where kids are at. We use initial fall scores to see who needs support where. MCAs are in the spring for grades 3-5. Math - Bridges Curriculum - very hands-on, very well-liked. Continuity across grade levels. Bridge to Read is our new ELA curriculum. Small groups for Math/Literacy interventions to help kids with specific skills. Every month, we get the Paw Print info newsletter for information on what's going on in school. Progress is reported in Report Cards in Parent Vue. Online only now. Make sure to visit your specialist teachers (gym/media/etc) during parent-teacher conferences. What can parents do: read 20 min at home each night, support regular attendance, attend family nights, and practice math skills. Our first title night is right before the Halloween Dance. Being a Title 1 school means that we receive extra support from adults to help our kids - Hooray! Most Title 1 funds are to pay for extra teachers, but there are also funds for family engagement, etc. New testing with aMath and aReading through Fast Bridge - with progress monitoring.
