LESSON CONTENT

Tua Colors & Meanings:

- **Green (Liturgy/Phụng Vụ)**
 - Used to reward good work ethics, liturgical rite activities, or works with growing faith or devotion
 - Ex: consistently going to LTT in the mornings during camp (and stays there even if an HT is around and doesn't leave after they leave), filled out their BHT
- **Blue (Activities/Sinh Hoạt)**
 - Used to reward activities of joyful dance, entertainment performance excellence, talented composers, especially those who create a fun environment during activities
 - Ex. HTDT, LTTT skits, TCL
- **Yellow (Academic/Học Tập)**
 - Used to reward learning activities, test reports, creative/artistic items
 - Ex. lessons, test scores, participation
- **Brown (Servant Leadership/Lãnh Đạo Phục Vụ)**
 - To reward and encourage members to live the spirit of servant leadership
- **Red (Spirit/Tinh Thần)**
 - Used to reward comprehensive spirit (natural & spiritual), mental patience, selflessness, dedication, teamwork
 - Ex. good teamwork, quick nghiêm tập for the group, cheering on/supporting each other in a team
