

Study Abroad in Ecuador

Ecuador Scholars Program

Experience the incredible beauty and biodiversity of Ecuador. Explore the central and coastal regions of this South American country, the westernmost country located on the equator, which boasts a unique ecological heritage.

Supported by our institutional partner university, ESPOL (Escuela Superior Politécnica del Litoral), participants will enjoy opportunities that are as diverse as the country itself including study of native plant and animal species, livestock production, tropical agriculture, aquaculture and coastal biology, wildlife conservation and the ecology of the Pacific Coast, the Andes Mountains and the Amazon Jungle all while immersed in the Ecuadorian culture. A visit to Puerto Lopez -Isla de la Plata (known as the “mini Galapagos”) may additionally be included in this program.

The UF associated courses, ANSC485 OR BIOL236 (Core+ R2 credit available), are each a 3-credit spring term course, during which students will prepare for the program through basic language practice, cultural study, program planning, and cohort team-building.

- Program cost (anticipated to be \$3,700 - \$3,900) includes 3 UF credits, round-trip airfare, insurance, housing, 1-2 meals per day and guided cultural tours.
- Cost does NOT include passport expenses, vaccinations, personal or incidental expenses.
- Financial Aid CAN be used!
