Gender and Sexuality Diversity Workshop

Description:

The training will be in person, with lots of time for Q and A and discussion. The workshop will focus on how to create safe and inclusive space for LGBTQI+ people, particularly in intersectional spaces .

The session will cover the following:

- Identify different sexualities, genders and relationship styles and how this relates to people that you engage with
- Use current language for trans/LGBTQ+ people and be aware of current issues
- Practise how to challenge homophobia and transphobia in different work contexts
- Explain how you can support LGBTQ+ young people you might work in your team
- Understand gender as bio-psycho-social and how this understanding can help in your work
- Practise how to support LGBTQ+ people that might come out to you
