

## **SITE VISIT QUESTIONS**

The following are representative of the types of questions that will be asked during the site visit as a whole. Different groups will be asked different questions, as appropriate to their roles in the collaborative.

### **Pathway Development**

- *What are the major achievements to date and next steps in developing the career pathway? (Please note that only one pathway will be discussed during the site visit.)*
- *How is the collaborative embedding work-based learning opportunities into the pathway?*
- *What if any hurdles are anticipated in implementing this pathway?*
- *What has been working well so far?*
- *What are root causes of any major changes to the pathway implementation plan so far?*

### **RWE Student Success Strategies**

- *What are the major achievements to date and next steps in implementing the two RWEs? (Please note that only two RWEs will be discussed during the site visit.)*
- *What if any hurdles are anticipated in implementing these RWEs?*
- *What has been working well so far?*
- *How do the RWEs interact with the career pathway?*

### **Data System and Tools**

- *How far along is the implementation of CCGI?*
- *What if any hurdles have you encountered?*

### **Regional Collaboration**

- *How were employers identified and recruited and how are they involved?*
- *What roadblocks do partners face in building trust, capacity, and sustained relationships, and how are these mitigated?*
- *How has this project work impacted relationships with other collaboratives in the region?*
- *Does the collaborative as a whole have adequate staff capacity to do the planned work?*

### **Governance**

- *How is the collaborative governed? How are decisions made?*
- *Does the collaborative have a process for making sub-grant awards to organizations other than the main collaborative partners? Describe.*
- *Does the collaborative have contractors or consultants doing major aspects of the work? Describe.*

### **Other**

- *What are some areas where more assistance or support could have been or could be useful?*
