- 1. The evolution of DigIn classes
  - a. We create classes as one-hour sessions
    - i. We had been packaging these as 3-hour in-person sessions
    - ii. Issues with "packaging tracks" (intro, beyond, expert) vs when someone could actually attend
    - iii. Staff that needed them couldn't get release time
  - b. Run them 2-3 times to fine-tune them
  - c. Send them to OTIS to make them:
    - i. polished webinars with both practice and a quiz
    - ii. CTLE credit ranging from 15-45 min
    - iii. Tracking that they share with us
