

ENROLLING IN THE IB DIPLOMA PROGRAMME AT KAUNAS JESUIT HIGH SCHOOL 2026

The International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme (IB DP) is a unique opportunity for students of grades III-IV to unleash their full personal potential and to develop effective learning skills for successful university studies in future. This program is based upon the well-balanced educational plan that aims at the highest academic achievement. The IB Diploma is recognized by the best universities of the world. Students wishing to enroll in the IB DP at Kaunas Jesuit High School (KJHS) must complete all of the standard KJHS admissions procedures.

Following KJHS teachers' recommendations, the Admission Committee may accept a Pre-IB student to the IB DP programme without the Admission Test (Entrance Exam). They must submit the completed Application Form without the *Application fee*.

Stages	Dates	Notes
1. Online Application submission form	February 2 – April 20	Submit the completed online Application Form https://forms.gle/nRxXwg7iS37BB9p19 by Parent(s) / Legal Guardians.
2. Application fee	until April 20	Application and Assessment fee is 60 EUR. Application fee has to be transferred to the school bank account No. LT85 4010 0425 0070 9680, bank AB LUMINOR, bank code is No 40100. It is required to state the purpose of the payment as “Application fee to IB Programme”, to mention the student's name and surname.
3. Applicant's code	within 2 working days	A code is submitted to every applicant online after receiving the Application fee.
4. Additional documents	until April 25	Submit the following documents to by email priemimas@kjjg.lt : a certified copy of the report card from the first term of year 10 or 11 (except KJHS students); a certified copy of the school report book accepted.
5. Registration for admission test	11.30 am – 11.50 am, April 25	The applicant must have a passport and the code received by email.
6. Admission Test	12.00 am, April 25 (duration 2 hours)	Requirements for entrance exam (English and Mathematics) . Accompanying persons are not allowed to stay on the school premises.
7. Publication of test results	till 4 pm, May 5	Test results will be announced individually by email.
8. Admission Committee Interview with successful applicants	2 pm – 7 pm, May 21–27	An applicant is interviewed by the Admission Committee after having passed the entrance examinations. Date and time of the Interview will be announced together with test results. The applicant's Parents or Legal Guardians are

		required to participate in the interview.
9. Announcement of the enrolled and rejected applicants	until 8 pm, May 28	Announcement of enrolled and rejected applicants by email. Favourable consideration: • Students showing proof of successful participation in republican and international competitions • Students with excellent previous academic record • Students applying as transfers from another IB school or honour program
10. Agreement Signing	until June 1	Signing of Agreement by successful students and Parent(s)/Legal Guardians. If not available, signed copies of the contract will be emailed.
11. Submission of additional documents	until June 5	The students must bring to the secretarial office (B108) the following or to by email priemimas@kjg.lt: • a contract with the KJHS; • digital photo (3X4 cm); • a copy of a student's mark and achievement certificate provided by the Middle school (at the end of form 10 or 11); • a copy of a birth certificate; • a copy of a passport / identity card; • a form provided by KJHS.

Tuition and fees

- ❖ IB Diploma Programme students must pay annual 1200 EUR tuition fees.
- ❖ During the last IB DP year, students have to pay subject registration fees for each taken subject exam and post office expenses (approx. 600 EUR). The fees are changed every year.
- ❖ Student from a low income household may get a special support grant if he/she is eligible to receive income support. It is advisable to make an application to the fund till the middle of September or January. Amounts approved under the fund will vary depending on factors such as the needs of each individual applicant and the overall level of demand for the fund.
