

Parents,

Here is some information to help you begin to prepare for your child's return to school if they will be returning in Group A or Group B.

Students will have a **temperature check** prior to entering the building from the carpool and the bus lot.

Students with a **temperature of 100.4** or higher will be screened by the nurse, sent to the Isolation Room and parents will be called.

A student who presents with a temperature in the carpool will not be able to enter the building and must return home with the parent.
