This is a list of summer programs that TUSD students have used in previous years, but there are many more programs out there.

YOU MUST GO DIRECTLY TO THE PROGRAM WEBSITE TO REGISTER YOURSELF

- It is the responsibility of the student/parent/guardian to check if courses are WASC accredited, UC approved, and NCAA approved. Refer to individual websites for this information as well as enrollment procedures. **Health course does not need to be UC approved.**
- Students are allowed to earn up to 40 credits for advancement from outside educational institutions, however, courses are limited to a **maximum of 10 credits per academic discipline.**
- **Students must register themselves for any summer classes.**

Summer Health Classes and the California Healthy Youth Act (CHYA): The California Healthy Youth Act (CHYA) requires school districts to ensure that all pupils in grades seven to twelve receive comprehensive sexual health education and HIV prevention education.
