Minutes

Zone Commander's update (5 & 6) & Discussion w/ Community

Zone 5 - Lieutenant Williams reported a 24% year-to-date drop in Zone 5 crime, primarily due to fewer burglaries and car break-ins, though aggravated assaults and robberies remain a concern. Fewer shooting victims were noted. The team discussed recent events, including a domestic violence standoff and a cleared suspicious package at Peachtree Center Mall. Upcoming events include a Mercedes-Benz match (March 28th), a No Kings protest (25,000 attendees), and six permitted 404 Day events. Concerns about tent encampments in Castleberry Hill and street racing/parties on Mangum Street were raised by Karrie; Lieutenant Williams will address these with Captain Welch and Major Hunt.

- Noise complaint about a street performer near Pemberton Place to the NPU-M Public Safety. [Will talk to the person and ask to comply with noise ordinance. If not he will be cited.](#)
- Track races through Castleberry Hill > residents not able to leave their home. Castleberry Point (333 Nelson Street but their garage entrance is off Chapel bw COP and Elliott St) were told they couldn't exit their garage. [Working on a better plan.](#)
- 261 Peters St SW - Roots & Beats (Omni Coffee & Eggs) - [License and Permit Issue. Will reach out to them.](#)
Got several citations issued:
 - *Case # 260310072: Ofc. Wilson was conducting an 89 in the area 261 Peter's St when he heard music coming from the establishment. At the scene Ofc. Wilson gave Jonathan Arzola (manager) a copy of charges for Prohibited Conduct 74-131 (loud music).*
 - *Case # 260310216: Ofc. Webb responded to 261 Peters St at 0130 hrs, the establishment was still up and running for business. They were shut down, and Jonathan Arzola (manager) was cited for Hours of operation Sec. 16-20N.0010 (b).*
- CRU at 301 Peters open outside the hours outside of the Castleberry Hill Landmark District. [We ask APD to town cars parking in the street outside this location.](#)

- 621 Lounge at 299 Peters St operating without alcohol license and outside the hours of Castleberry Hill Landmark District. [License and Permit Issue. Will reach out to them.](#)

Zone 6 Major Webster

Major Webster (Zone 6) reported a 22% crime decrease year-over-year, focusing on car break-ins. Noise complaints at Icon's Sports Bar dropped due to a new beat officer. An encampment in front of Brushworks awaits DPW removal. Dorthey updated the Edgewood Task Force, noting most ordinances passed, street paving started, and a project manager is forthcoming.

 - New legislation for moratorium that came from the city's law department
