Answer key

1. What are greenhouse gases? What are the main ones?

Greenhouse gases are gases in Earth's atmosphere that trap heat. They let sunlight pass through the atmosphere, but they prevent the heat that the sunlight brings from leaving the atmosphere.

The main ones are Water vapor, Carbon dioxide, Methane, Ozone, Nitrous oxide and Chlorofluorocarbons.

2. Next click the "Weather and Climate tab" and describe to me how weather and climate are different.

Weather is a specific event, like a rainstorm or hot day, that happens over a few hours, days or weeks. Climate is the average weather conditions in a place over 30 years or more.
