property with 2 double and 1 single gate as it is currently. The double gates will be upgraded from 5 to 6 feet at no additional cost. All required township permits will be obtained.

Gas Lines:

- Every household will have their gas lines replaced (newer builds already had them replaced). Wind Turbine Project

- SCBC was an option for running power lines under the clubhouse to the power plant in Forked River. The State required 6 alternatives for running the power lines. SCBC was part of the 6 alternatives but was never seriously considered.
- 7 whales have washed up along the Jersey Shore. NJ Congressman Van Crew has demanded that all off shore wind activity be halted until it is properly determined what the effects of these activities are having on our marine life.
