



Further Learning Opportunities (FLO) 2025-26

Background:

Middle School is an important time in life for all students. We believe in the need for “down-time” for students, and also for students to participate in things such as Girl/Boy Scouts, church activities, sports, arts, music, recreational activities, etc.

In addition to these understandings, we want to be clear about daily expectations and further learning opportunities:

- Everyday, students should complete any assigned homework, or other work not completed in class.
- Everyday, students will read for 30 minutes, outside of class-assigned material.
- Our Grading is Mastery Based. This means:
 - Any student not demonstrating Mastery, should still be working to fully understand the concepts, standards or skills in every class. If a student needs help, the student needs to ask.
 - Any student meeting Mastery should be completing Extension opportunities provided by the teacher, or co-constructed with a teacher. If a student is ready for Extension, and not aware of an opportunity, the student needs to ask.
- If families feel that their students need more structure or time filled once school is over, we are able to offer additional, supplemental opportunities known as “Further Learning Opportunities” for students.

Purpose:

The purpose of Further Learning Opportunities at VIDA is to provide additional high-quality supplemental activities for students to engage within a more independent fashion to help achieve the Vision we have for the future of our students.

Personal Brand website	The purpose of “Curating your Vida” is to encourage students to develop a positive online presence in the digital world through structured online opportunities that include: Curating & Sharing Work, Digital Citizenship, and sowing the seeds of a Personal Brand. The primary vehicle for this will be through the creation of a website (formally referred to as “Digital Portfolio”). There will be times that VIDA will assign tasks and development to be done on their websites during Monday Touching Base time in Design Labs. NEWSELA	Newsela allows students to keep up-to-date on current events with specially curated stories that are adjustable to their lexile levels. In addition to current events, Newsela also has content-specific articles in science, ELA, and social studies. Students can also take short multiple-choice quizzes at the end of their readings. Thrively	Thrively is an online student-centered platform for students to gain an understanding of their personal strengths, interests and aspirations. Students have the opportunity to take ownership of learning through goal setting, build social-emotional skills, and build purpose through career pathways and action plans. Students build real-world skills through coursework that is laid out in multiple lessons that follow their interests and passions through reflection and/or projects.
