

RESOLUTION NO. 26-15

**RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE ISLA VISTA
COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT AND PARKING PLACE COMMISSION
AUTHORIZING ENFORCEMENT OF COUNTY PARKING REGULATIONS
PURSUANT TO THE CALIFORNIA VEHICLE CODE AND COUNTY BAIL
SCHEDULE**

WHEREAS, the Isla Vista Community Services District (the “District”) formed Parking District No. 1 pursuant Ordinance No. 1 to improve parking conditions within the District; and

WHEREAS, the District has established a Parking Place Commission pursuant to Ordinance No. 2 to operate, manage, and control parking places within Parking District No. 1; and

WHEREAS, the District has the authority to regulate parking within its Parking District No. 1 through its Parking Place Commission pursuant to state law and the October 14, 2025 Memorandum of Understanding with the County of Santa Barbara; and

WHEREAS, the District has entered into an Memorandum of Understanding with the County of Santa Barbara on October 14, 2025 to enforce parking regulations on County rights-of-way, and desires to enforce County bail schedules accordingly; and

WHEREAS, parking violations occurring on County rights-of-way are governed by the provisions of the California Vehicle Code, including but not limited to Vehicle Code sections 40200 et seq.; and

WHEREAS, bail amounts for such violations are established pursuant to Vehicle Code section 40203.5 and reflected in the County Uniform Bail Schedule adopted by the Superior Court of California, County of Santa Barbara; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors and Parking Place Commission desires to formally authorize enforcement consistent with the Vehicle Code framework and the County bail schedule.

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE ISLA VISTA
COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT AND PARKING PLACE COMMISSION DOES
HEREBY RESOLVE:**

1. **Recitals.** The Recitals set forth above are true and correct and are incorporated into this Resolution herein by reference.

2. **Authority.** Pursuant to the MOU with the County of Santa Barbara and applicable provisions of the California Vehicle Code, the District is authorized to enforce County-adopted parking regulations on County rights-of-way within the District’s jurisdictional boundaries.

3. **Nature of Violations.** Parking violations enforced pursuant to this Resolution shall be processed as civil parking violations under the California Vehicle Code administrative parking enforcement framework (Vehicle Code §§ 40200–40230).

4. **Applicable Bail Schedule.** Parking violations occurring on County rights-of-way shall be enforced in accordance with the County Uniform Bail Schedule, as established by the Superior Court of Santa Barbara County and authorized under Vehicle Code § 40203.5, and County ordinances. The County bail schedule is available on the Superior Court’s website and may be updated periodically.

5. **Issuance of Parking Citations.** Parking citations may be issued by District employees, agents, contractors, or other persons authorized by the District, including through the Parking Place Commission, or pursuant to agreements with the County of Santa Barbara.

6. **Appeals Process.** Review, appeal, payment processing, late penalties, and any related collection procedures shall be conducted in accordance with the California Vehicle Code, including Vehicle Code § 40215 and related provisions, and pursuant to procedures established under the MOU.

7. **Payment and Late Penalties.** Vehicle Code fines issued on County property shall be processed according to the County bail schedule and DMV registration hold procedures as applicable.

8. **Effective Date.** This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
