PROCEDURES:

- Evaluation personnel follow the Texas state guidelines for determining eligibility for orthopedic impairment.
- If a student who is referred for a special education evaluation requires an examination by a licensed physician and is not currently under the care of a primary doctor or specialist(s), the Bishop CISD will collaborate with the family to secure an examination(s) at no cost to the parent.
- The Bishop CISD provides a release of confidential information to the parent for their consent to communicate with any outside professional(s) from whom information will be requested in order to determine eligibility and/or provide recommendations to the ARD committee.


