Purpose

Austin ISD Early College High Schools are innovative high schools that partner with Austin Community College to allow students to attend college and have the opportunity to earn a high school diploma and up to 60 college credit hours at no cost to students or their families. To determine student readiness for college coursework, the partner colleges will assess students utilizing the TSIA2 required assessment instrument.

The college will use the following minimum passing standards to determine a student's readiness to enroll in freshman-level academic coursework.

Instrument	State TSIA 2.0 ELAR Standard	State TSIA 2.0 Math Standard
TSIA 2.0 Assessment	1. If you score in the range of 945–990 on the multiple-choice CRC Test and a 5 or higher on the Essay Test, or 2. If you score below 945 on the multiple-choice CRC Test, receive a diagnostic level of 5 or higher on the Diagnostic Test, and score of 5 or higher on the Essay Test.	1. If you score in the range of 950–990 on the CRC Test or 2. 2. If you score below 950 on the CRC Test but receive a diagnostic level of 6 on the Diagnostic Test.

Student Eligibility Requirements for Dual Credit: Students must complete a pre-assessment activity and practice test before taking the official Texas Success Initiative (TSI) assessment. To be eligible for enrollment in a dual credit course offered by a public college, students must meet all the college's standard prerequisite requirements designated for that course (e.g., a minimum score on a specified placement test, minimum grade in a specified previous course, etc.).
