City Park Circuit: FAQ

What time are the races?

9:00- Kids Quarter Mile (free and unofficial, just show up and run!)

9:30- Women's Race (all divisions)

10:00- Men's Race (all divisions)

Where does the race start?

The race starts and finishes at the City Park Pavillion. Look for the tents and finish line arch.

How long is the course?

The course is 2.0 miles, shorter than we originally planned. The City of Denver did not like our initial course that went out and around the art museum and made us alter it.

Do I need to check in and do packet pickup for my kid in the Kids Quarter Mile?

No- this is a free and unofficial race, no bib, shirt, packet pickup needed. Just show up to the start line at 9:00. We have medals for the kids!

Can I walk the race?

Yes, all abilities are welcome!

Can I bring my dog?

Yes, but please start in the back of the race and be conscious of runners with your leash.

Where should I park? (see map below)

You can park in the neighborhoods to the south of City Park or at Denver East High School. The park itself will be closed to the public on race-morning so we can keep the course clear.

Can my friends still register on race day?

Yes, registration will be open all morning- just go to the Denver Athletics tent by the start/finish or simply register on your phone using <u>RunSignUp</u>.

How can I get my award if I placed top 3 in my division?

Kids will get medals at the finish line- everyone else can stop by the Denver Athletics tent to claim their awards after results are official.

How do I do a shoe demo?

Check out the On and New Balance tents before the race, find a shoe you like, and wear it for the race! Get there early as sizes are limited.

Will there be water during the race?

Yes, we will have a water table set up at a mile with self-service, as well as a cooler at the finish.

Where can I find live results?

Go to the race registration tab, and click the tab that says results- or click here.

How does the team scoring work?

We will average the times of all 4 of your team members to determine top male, female, and co-ed teams.
