Program Description

The Master of Music Production with a Minor in Arts and Theater Ministry is designed for individuals who seek to integrate technical expertise in music production with faith-based artistic expression. This program equips students with skills in audio engineering, music composition, sound design, and performance, while also preparing them for leadership roles in worship arts and faith-driven theatrical productions.

Students will explore digital audio workstations, studio recording techniques, live sound engineering, and the theological foundations of worship music. The minor in arts and theater ministry provides specialized training in stage production, dramatic performance, and faith-based storytelling through music and arts.

Graduates will be prepared for careers in music production, worship leadership, theatrical ministry, and arts administration in faith-based and nonprofit organizations.

Admissions Requirements

- Bachelor's degree in music production, fine arts, or a related field
- Minimum GPA of 3.0
- Two letters of recommendation from music or ministry professionals
- Statement of purpose outlining career goals in music production and arts ministry
- Interview with faculty admissions committee

Practicum Requirement

Students must complete a 300-hour supervised practicum in a recording studio, church music ministry, or performing arts organization. This hands-on experience allows students to apply technical and creative skills in faith-based music and theater production.

Master's Thesis

A master's thesis is required, focusing on music composition, sound engineering, worship arts, or faith-based theater production. The thesis should be between 60-100 pages, follow APA formatting, and provide original research or creative work in the field of music production and arts ministry.

- Enhance digital ministry effectiveness through data-driven insights.
