


# **BIST Year 4E Weekly Update**

## Literacy

During this shortened week the students spent some time looking at
the theme of gratefulness as we also celebrated the American tradition
of Thanksgiving. Thusly, one of our mentor texts this week was the
The Giving Tree by Shel Silverstein. To say that the students had a lot
to say about this book would be an understatement. Rich discussion
ensued around this moving parable that offers an affecting
interpretation of the gift of giving and a serene acceptance of another's
capacity to love in return.



- This week the students seemed come to an understanding of all the hard work that a great piece of writing takes; including revision. As experience teaches us this is often the hardest part of the writing process for young writers to engage in. However, true to form this hard working group of learners dug in and many have completed a well written, edited, and revised Non-Chronological Report. Next up - poetry!

#### **IPC**
