Referees

Referee Eligibility: must be paid up members of Judo Ontario with minimum Regional, or other Provincial/Territorial associations, or IJF recognized Association with similar certification.

Novice referees are welcome but eligibility to referee specific age and level categories will be determined by the Chief Referee on the day of the event.

Awards

1st, 2nd and two 3rd place medals will be awarded as per Judo Canada guidelines.

Medals will be awarded as each division finishes.

Team Champions will receive individual medals and be presented a single team trophy.

No other awards for teams.

Weigh-ins

All participants (u16 up) must come to the official weigh-in with their 2025-2026 Judo Canada membership card. All athletes must weigh-in wearing their judogi pants and a t-shirt with no exceptions. **No stripping of clothing will be allowed.**

Weigh-ins will be on the day of the competition at the tournament site.

Special Note Honour system used for u10-u14, see allowances section below.

Allowances are as follows:

U10-U14 none, we will use the honour system as per the SANCTIONING POLICY & TOURNAMENT STANDARDS 2025-2026 (August 30 2025)

"5.3.5. Honour System (page 31)

Honour system can be used for U14 and younger divisions, with weights being sent in kg with registrations. In that case, random weigh-in checks may be used by the organizers as described in the technical package of the event. Weight tolerance should be indicated in the package."

We do reserve the right to do random weight checks for u14 and lower categories.

The maximum weight difference between the lightest and heaviest competitor is not more than 15% of the lightest competitor.

U16-U18 600 grams (Note - Any u14 athletes competing in u16 divisions will need to weigh in).

U21 800 grams.

Senior & Veterans 1kg.

****Team Competition ONLY**** - all athletes are granted 1kg allowance.

Athlete Rules and Eligibility

- Must be a paid up member of a Judo Ontario.
- Yellow belt minimum rank allowed.
- **White judogi mandatory for all athletes.**
- IJF Current Rules Modified by NSO & PSO Regulations apply.
- Modified double elimination for all divisions with 6 or more athletes, round robin for divisions with 5 or less.
- The Tournament Director with the approval of the Chief Official reserves the right to delete, combine, or alter any category or division if necessary, for the successful running of this tournament.
- Any division changes affecting minors must have parental written consent of all competitors in NEW/RECEIVING DIVISION.
- Any division changes affecting adult competitors must have the written consent of all competitors in the receiving division.
- **TEAM COMPETITION** is **single elimination**, the winning team moves to next round, no repechage.
 - Senior level rules & regulations. Blue belt and up. U18 athletes allowed.
 - **White & Blue judogis MANDATORY** - one team in white, one team in blue.
 - Mixed team, 3 females and 3 males.
 - The first team to win 4 matches advances to the next round.
 - 3-3 Tie breaker will be a random draw for weight class.
 - Dojoshu/coach will provide a team list of 6 athletes to the Tournament Director.
 - Team members will be weighed for their weight category.

- Wgts F -57, -70, +70
- Wgts M -73, -90, +90

*belt rank groupings will ultimately be decided by the Tournament Director based on registrations. Half ranks are treated as the lower half (i.e. orange-green is treated as orange). Intermediate divisions could be removed for u18/u21/Sr if deemed necessary (Advanced Green and up).

****Note** - Modified Medical Rules: All U14, U16 and U18 contestants will be allowed two one-minute free medical examinations per competitor per match (does not include treatments for bleeding) without penalty. A third examination for the same injury to the same competitor in the same match will result in their opponent being awarded the win by "Kikengachi". All incidents of bleeding in these two age categories will be dealt with in accordance with current IJF Competition Rules, Article 29 (Bleeding Injuries).
