Matteo Maiero highlighted that the demos for our <u>current testbeds</u> are broken. He asked working group members if they are willing to second Eurotech in repairing them and refreshing the related content on our website, since some of the organizations mentioned have left the Eclipse Foundation.

Benjamin Cabé mentioned that it is difficult to have a discussion on this topic, since we do not have an official definition of what a testbed is. Jens Reimann commented that maybe a live cloud hosted demo is not a mandatory requirement. Several attendees agreed that making sample code available is a useful tool to drive adoption of Eclipse IoT technologies.

Call participants agreed to continue the discussion on this topic during next month's call.

# 3. <u>loT Packages</u> project update

The project delivered the initial version of <u>Cloud2Edge</u>, its very first package. Cloud2Edge deploys a pre-configured IoT cloud backend made of <u>Eclipse Ditto</u>, <u>Eclipse hawkBit</u> and <u>Eclipse Hono</u>.

The IoT Packages project also hosts individual Helm charts for the projects mentioned above. Edgeworx intends to contribute a Helm chart for <u>Eclipse ioFog</u> to the project soon.
