SANBORN REGIONAL HIGH SCHOOL ~ LOCAL SCHOLARSHIPS

Sanborn Regional High School partners with in-house and local scholarship committees to offer scholarship money to Sanborn senior students for their postsecondary educational plans.

The scholarships are divided into 3 categories:

Category 1 includes scholarships from local groups. The selection committee members are volunteer SRHS staff. This category uses the General Scholarship Application with essay. Some may include specific essay requirements. Completed applications are brought to the high school Counseling Office.

Category 2 includes scholarships from local groups with their own selection committees. This category uses the General Scholarship Application with essay. Some may include specific essay requirements. Completed applications are sent **directly to the committee's address**.

Category 3 also includes scholarships from local groups with their own selection committees, but they provide a specific application with specific essay requirements. Completed applications are sent **directly to the committee's address**.

IMPORTANT NOTE ON DISBURSEMENT OF FUNDS: In many schools/programs, your tuition bill may be due before your scholarship check is disbursed. In this case, you would need to pay the money owed to your school/program when due & apply the scholarship money at a later date. **Before the school year starts, talk with your individual college/program bursar's office about a plan.**

BEFORE YOU START, REVIEW THIS SHEET

Read through the ENTIRE packet to become familiar with the process. Read each scholarship description and decide which ones you are interested in and which you qualify for (eligibility examples: attended DJ Bakie School, live in Fremont, plan on majoring in Health Sciences, etc.)
Pick up your transcript in the Counseling Office
Review the Financial Aid Letter from your college and your FAFSA Submission Summary (if you filed a FAFSA).
Prepare your Resume - check resume samples in Google Docs
Request Letters of Recommendation or Reference - give people at least 2 weeks notice - REQUEST NOW! College Reference letters may need to be edited for this purpose.
Gather your college/program Letter(s) of Acceptance or emails
Categories 1 & 2 - Fill out your General Application. Prepare your essay. Check to see if additional/specific essays are required. Category 3 - Fill out Specific Applications. Prepare any specific essays.
Make copies of your materials. (cannot be done in Counseling Office) Category 1 - Copy one full set of required documents (including any extra essay) and submit to the Counseling Office Categories 2 & 3 - These applications are going to different committees. You will need one set of required docs for each separate application.
Prepare envelopes. Buy postage for those applications that require mailing. DEADLINES ARE FIRM - Allow for delivery time. Local mail delivery may take 2-4 days at least. Check each scholarship for the deadline. Category 1 scholarships do NOT need to be put in an envelope. You can paperclip them or put them in a simple folder. Drop off at the Counseling Office any day leading up to, but before 2:10 , on deadline day. Category 2 scholarships are mailed or hand-delivered (only if allowed - see individual scholarship). Category 3 scholarships are mailed or hand-delivered (only if allowed - see individual scholarship). If a Category 2 or 3 committee is housed at the high school or middle school, you may ask Ms. Haley in the Main Office to put them in the scholarship box - PLEASE CLEARLY LABEL WITH SCHOLARSHIP NAME - ALLOW 1 DAY FOR DELIVERY - BE MINDFUL OF DEADLINE!

Definitions of some terms used in this document:

***Disbursement:** the act of paying out money from a fund. Depending on the scholarship, you may receive the money at our awards night, or a check may be sent directly to your school/program after you complete a semester.

***IMPORTANT NOTE ON DISBURSEMENT OF FUNDS:**

Although a scholarship award may say “after completion of postsecondary 1st semester”, in many schools, your tuition bill may be due before your scholarship check is disbursed. In this case, you would need to pay the money owed to your school when due and apply the scholarship money at a later date - **before your school year starts, talk with your individual college/program’s bursar’s office about a plan.**

Matriculate: to enroll as a member of a college/program. If you were enrolled for 1st semester, a scholarship may require that you “matriculate” or enroll (with proof) into 2nd semester to receive the funds. In this case, request a “Verification of Enrollment” form for the 2nd semester time period.

Postsecondary Education: education after high school

Primary Eligibility: suitability to be chosen (for example, live in a particular town, have a particular interest, or intend a particular major).

Semester: the fall term of a college/program, usually spanning from Aug/Sept through Dec/Jan. At the end of the semester, grades close and credit is earned. Transcripts then become available. Tuition is generally due before the semester starts.
